About National Museum:

- Is a public scientific institution which systematically collects, researches and exhibits natural and historical collections from all over the world.
- Is **the oldest museum** in Bohemia and today the most distinguished and largest museum in Czech republic
- At present shelters almost 20 milion of items from the area of natural history, history, archeology, arts, music and librarianship
- Keeps a collection of manuscripts, incunabula and old prints and documents from Bohemia documenting the development of **book culture** in the 19th and 20th centuries.
